



Safety Rules and Responsibilities

To ensure a safe environment for members and guests on the Winnipeg Trap and Skeet Club grounds please adhere to the following safety rules and responsibilities:

- No guns are allowed inside the Clubhouse
- Hearing and eye protection must be worn while shooting
- No smoking on the shooting line or active field
- All guns must have actions visibly open at all times
- The direction of the muzzle must be controlled at all times. Muzzle(s) should be pointed towards the ground or downrange and never pointed at anyone
- All guns must remain in one of the provided racks unless in transit to the fields or on an active Trap or Skeet squad
- Only shotgun shells with lead shot to a maximum pellet size of 7 1/2 with a maximum load of 1 1/8 oz are allowed. Steel shot is not permitted
- A gun can only be loaded when at a shooting station or stand, it is your turn to shoot, feet are firmly planted and the muzzle is pointed downrange
- Load only one (1) shell for American Trap, two (2) shells for Trap, Double Trap and International Trap
- Load only (2) shells for American Skeet except for Station 8 when only one (1) shell is required
- When shooting doubles, remember if two (2) targets are broken on your first shot the gun is still loaded
- In the event of a misfire, keep the muzzle(s) pointed safely downrange and wait 30 seconds before opening the action
- No unsupervised children on the shooting line or active field
